

### Unleashing the Superpower: India's Journey to a \$35 Trillion Economy

With India's GDP estimated to hit \$30-35 trillion by 2047, the country is well on its way to becoming a global superpower, thanks to a young population, an expanding middle class, a thriving digital economy, and its focus on sustainability. The country, however, must address several challenges and successfully navigate emerging geopolitical tensions to achieve the vision for 2047.

### India's Rs 65-lakh crore consumer market set to skyrocket, eyeing top 2 global spot in the next two decades

India's Rs 65-lakh crore consumer market is on track for exponential growth, aiming to secure a top 2 global position within the next two decades. Driven by rising incomes, urbanization and a booming middle class, this surge positions India as a major player in global consumption, presenting vast opportunities for businesses and investors eyeing the expanding Indian market.

### India hub driving global AI innovation; new campus plans on track: SAP Labs

SAP Labs India, the largest R&D hub for the German software maker outside its headquarters, is focused on driving global AI innovations. Managing Director Sindhu Gangadharan announced plans for a new campus in Bengaluru, with the first phase already under construction. This phase, costing €80 million, is expected to be completed by Q2 2025, marking a significant expansion for SAP in India.

### ➢ Get set for India's biggest ever IPO as Sebi greenlights Hyundai Motor Co's issue of around \$3 bn; launch likely in October

South Korean auto giant Hyundai Motor Co's Indian arm Hyundai Motor India Limited is one step closer to launching its proposed initial public offer of around \$3 billion, with market regulator Sebi giving the go ahead for the mega issue. If the listing plans fructify, this deal, a pure OFS or offer for sale by the promoter, would be India Inc's biggest-ever IPO and beat the earlier record set by state-owned LIC's \$2.7 bn listing in 2022.






### ADVENTURE CLUB: EXPEDITIONS TO CHIKKATIRUPATI & UTTARI BETTA

### A GLORIOUS CELEBRATION OF 78 YEARS OF INDEPENDENCE




The NSB, Bangalore, commemorated the 78th Independence Day of India with a grand celebration on August 15, 2024.

This summit was more into practical insights of corporate world, particularly in marketing domain.


